LOCATION

Miracle Ranch is on Horseshoe Lane off Highway 16. Directions to the ranch are located on the back of this flyer. All tribes will be assigned cabins but personal tents are welcomed and encouraged. ***Sleeping bags and pillows are a must regardless of where you intend to sleep.*** You must remember to register. Do it today so you don't forget!

ACTIVITIES

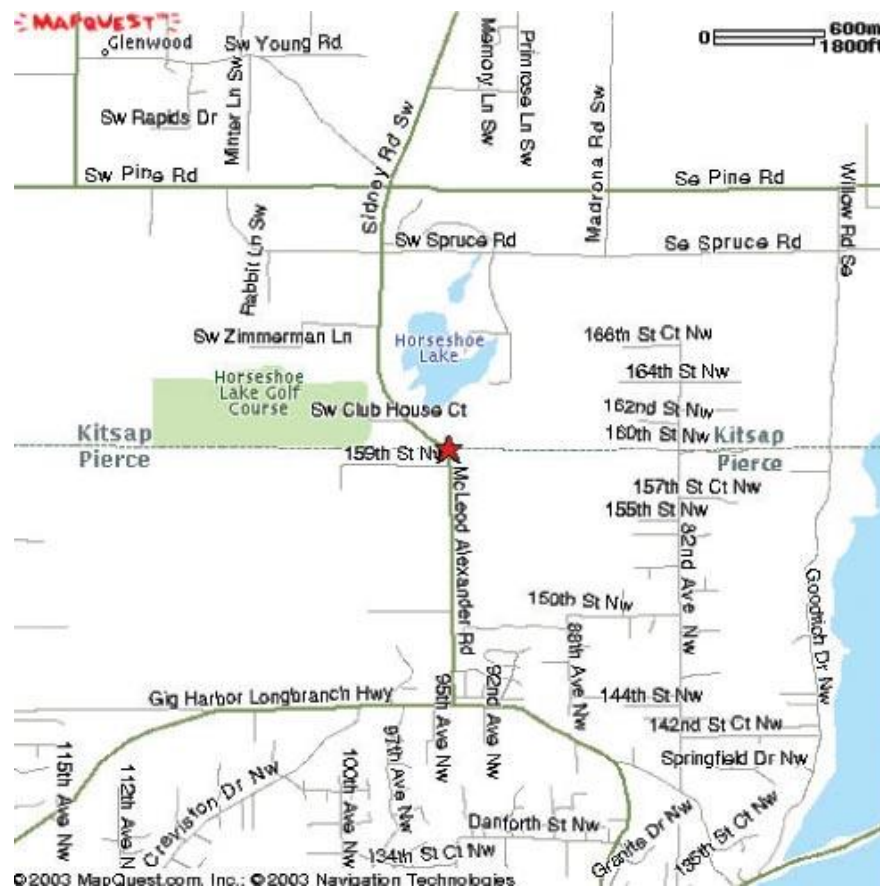
Boys and girls rodeos which entail participation by dads and kids in events like the sack race, ring relay, roping relay, barrel race, and piggy back relay. All that and horses too!!! There will also be trail rides, pony rides, Friday night at the movies, special craft, boating, capture the flag, the fort, swimming (for the brave) and basketball. Bring along your baseball gloves and balls, Frisbees, and indoor games. The weekend is capped off with the traditional campfire on Saturday Night and events include the Tribe skits, Sunnyside, Graduation, and naming of the new Longhouse and the **NEW NATION CHIEF**.

TRAIL AND PONY RIDE

Trail and pony rides are for the children only and by reservation. This year the cost of the rides is already included in your fees. Trail rides on the horses are for children 7 years and older. If the wranglers feel uncomfortable regarding your child's size or abilities, regardless of the age, they do reserve the right to deny the ride. Pony rides are for the younger children and require the assistance of the parent.

DIRECTIONS TO MIRACLE RANCH

Follow highway 3 south to Gorst. Continue around the inlet on highway 16 southeast. Take the second exit which is Sedwick Road. Turn right (west) at the exit ramp stoplight. Proceed to the next stoplight. Turn left onto Sidney Road. Proceed seven (7) miles to Miracle Ranch. As the road passes the Horseshoe Lake County Park it makes a sharp right turn. Prior to entering into the right turn, take a left into the dirt driveway to Miracle Ranch.



Remember to bring sleeping bags, toiletries, towels, raingear, swimsuits, sunscreen, flashlights, walkie-talkies, and extra warm clothes.

For the Dad's: remember to pack aspirin, Motrin, Benedryl, Sudafed, bug repellent, bandages, splints (for fingers, wrists, femurs, etc.), gauze, neck braces, Ben-gay, tape for broken ribs (duct tape should be good in a pinch), hammers, cards, poker chips, lots of money, and fire starter/matches for assisting the Haida with starting Saturday night's campfire.
